RevYouth Crews:

If you truly want to invest in students' lives, Crews are one of the best tools to do so. Crews provide an environment for students to connect more deeply with one another and with you as the Crew Leader outside of the normal Sunday service. During Covid, RevYouth Crews were the lifeblood of the ministry. In a time where meeting in large numbers was out of the question, our Crews (small groups) allowed us to continue to invest in our students without missing a beat. Although the structure and time of Crews may change due to the season we are in as a ministry the heart behind them will always remain the same: make a large youth ministry smaller. The significance of smaller is better conversations and connections. Over the years we have seen God work mightily through our Crews as students have truly gotten out of their comfort zone and gone deeper both relationally and spiritually.

Questions to ask yourself before becoming a RevYouth Leader

Am I willing to leave my problems at the door in order to focus solely on the students and what they are facing?

We all face struggles, and all have things we need prayer for and we want to discuss with our friends. At Rev you will create new relationships with fellow leaders and as such you will want to be open and share life with them. While that is something we want to happen, we need to be careful not to make Rev somewhere that we can just get together and talk about ourselves. We need to remember and remind ourselves every Sunday night that we are here for the students and to help them in their struggles. Whatever we may be going through it needs to be pushed aside for the few hours that we are with the students.

Am I flexible with change and growth in this ministry?

We have been blessed with a growing ministry, and because of our growth and the fact that we do not have everything figured out we will constantly change to try new things in order to reach new students. Because of this it is important that we are all flexible with change at Rev.

Do I still feel committed to this ministry?

If we are not careful, Rev will become just another thing on our schedule each week and we will begin just going through the motions, but to be effective ministers to students we have to be committed to coming and giving our best each week.

Can you be consistent?

Consistency is very important to us because we believe the students are worth it. We have seen the benefits of students being able to build relationships with leaders and count on them being available. If you're unable to serve consistently, RevYouth may not be the best fit for your schedule. We will be holding you accountable to your commitment to serve weekly even if you are consistent in letting us know you'll have to miss.
